All applicants are required to take either the General Test of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) in time for the results to reach the Department of Finance by the application deadline. International students must also submit an official report of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
